# CHAMPAGNE

## **Cristal Brut** 295.00

Cristal, the jewel of the Louis Roederer House, needs no introduction. This Champagne was created for Tsar Alexander II in 1876 and has silky, velvety textures which provide perfect overtones for the wine's glorious freshness.

## **Doyard Cuvée Libertine** 195.00

Doyard Cuvée Libertine is the result of a 10 year research project and is a unique and utterly delicious Champagne from a blend of 12 Chardonnay wines of four top vintages. It is then cellar aged for 12 years. This Champagne is also produced in an authentically shaped bottle with the cork restrained by hemp cord and a wax seal. The initial sweetness is beautifully balanced by lime and gooseberry acidity.

# PROSECCO 'GOLD'

## **Bottega Gold, Prosecco Brut** 60.00 magnum

Sandro Bottega has made a life's work of creating the finest Prosecco. Not content with sourcing the best grapes and developing the best wine-making practices, he also developed the 'liquid gold' packaging. A stunning presentation and a soft, elegant and perfect celebration magnum.

# WHITE WINES

## Sauvignon Blanc 40.00

*Sancerre La Grande Chatelaine  
Joseph Mellot, Loire*

This Sancerre is quite simply one of the finest you will taste. It is barrel fermented in a small cellar under the medieval town and is from one of the top houses and winemakers. An intense, wonderful Sauvignon Blanc.

## Marsanne 85.00

*Hermitage Blanc Chapoutier, Rhône*

100% Marsanne from three separate vineyard sites in order to deliver incredible richness, balance and flavour. Complex and subtle with hints of walnut, honey, acacia and white currants.

## Chardonnay 90.00

*Chablis Grand Cru les Preuses  
Louis Jadot, Burgundy*

Les Preuses is one of the top vineyards of Chablis and this is a wonderful example. Eighteen months barrel ageing adds weight and power to classic Chablis minerality.

## Chardonnay 48.00

*Sanford, Santa Barbara, California*

The Chardonnay comes from two vineyards in the Santa Rita Hills, La Rinconada and Sanford & Benedict. This is recognised as one of California's great Chardonnays, displaying the complexity of Burgundy but with lovely tropical fruit hints on the palate and aroma.

## Chardonnay 99.00

*Puligny Montrachet Premier Cru  
Clos de la Garenne, Domaine Duc de  
Magenta, Burgundy*

Management of this special vineyard and production of the wine is carried out by one of the great Burgundy wine-making houses which results in a wonderfully stylish wine, generous in flavour yet elegant and complex.

## Grenache/Syrah 50.00

*Mirabeau Pure Rosé, Côtes de Provence*

<b>Malbec</b> <i>Salentein Primus, Uco Valley, Argentina</i> Malbec is the ultimate steak wine. This is the ultimate Malbec. High altitude vineyard, remarkable wine making, 19 months barrel ageing in French oak. Sensational.	55.00	<b>Pinot Noir</b> <i>Corton Pougets Domaine des Héritiers Louis Jadot, Burgundy</i> This exceptional vineyard site and domaine was purchased by Louis Jadot in 1914. Corton is one of Burgundy's great Grand Cru and this 10 year old Pougets, perfectly demonstrates the silky elegance and warmth that sets Burgundy apart from Pinot Noir produced anywhere else in the world.	120.00
<b>Shiraz</b> <i>Shingleback, McLaren Vale, Australia</i> This is the top Shiraz wine produced by the Davey family from their renowned Shingleback vineyard. Whilst typically Australian in its power and generosity, the wine also displays multi-faceted flavours of strawberry, blackberry, cherry with fine tannin structure.	45.00	<b>Syrah</b> <i>Cornas, La Louvée Jean Luc Colombo, Rhône Valley</i> Jean Luc Colombo is considered to be the wizard of the Rhône. His extraordinary Cornas wines have a worldwide demand. La Louvée is one of the most intense, deep and concentrated reds - a true benchmark for the Syrah grape.	115.00
<b>Cabernet Sauvignon</b> <i>Don Maximiano Founder's Reserve, Aconcagua Valley, Chile</i> This is Chile's first super-premium wine; the 1995 vintage won Chile's first ever Gold Medal at the International Wine Challenge. A fantastic expression of the Cabernet Sauvignon grape, concentrated with deep blackcurrant overlaid by vanilla and smoky cedarwood.	85.00	<b>Cabernet Sauvignon/Merlot</b> <i>Blason d'Issan, Margaux, Bordeaux</i> One of the standout wines from Bordeaux a dense, purple-coloured wine with beautiful aromatics of spring flowers, blueberries and dark raspberries. Jancis Robinson described this wine as having 'a lovely fragrant nose, pure Margaux, real quality and depth'.	60.00



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
